



Brian P. Stahl, P.E.

Mr. Stahl is the Deputy Base Civil Engineer at Tyndall Air Force Base, Florida and has spent over 30 years managing Air Force construction programs at numerous military bases around the world. On October 10, 2018 he served as the Emergency Operations Center Deputy Director at Tyndall when Hurricane Michael made landfall on the base. One of only four Category 5 hurricanes to directly strike the US, Michael damaged or destroyed over 480 facilities and caused nearly four billion dollars of damage on the installation. The federal government has committed to rebuilding the installation and turning it into the Air Force Base of the Future over the next few years. Mr. Stahl has been a key figure and leader in the initial recovery, master planning, design, and execution of this massive rebuild program. He received his bachelor's degree in Biomedical Engineering from Louisiana Tech University in 1989 and graduated from the University of Texas at San Antonio with an MBA in 1998. He is also a retired US Air Force Reserve Colonel and a licensed professional engineer in state of Florida.
